## Inproba BV MOSH/MOAH policy

Inproba BV is committed to deliver consistently safe and quality products to optimally satisfy the demands of our customers.

We are aware of the issue surrounding the potential presence of Mineral Oil Saturated Hydrocarbons (MOSH) and Mineral Oil Aromatic Hydrocarbons (MOAH) in food packaging and potential migration into food products.

Studies suggest that there are numerous potential sources of contamination.

These include food contact materials (like for instance the use of recycled paper and board), contaminants (like some lubricating oils) and processing aids (for instance release agents).

Currently there is no detailed insight in exactly which (categories of) raw and processed food products are at high(er) risk.

Therefore European and national authorities have initiated investigations into (1) methods of analysis and (2) measurements of MOSH/MOAH in food samples of various kinds.

Once methods of analyses will be validated and approved by EFSA, the road to EU defined maximum levels is open. Even though this is currently not yet the case, a HPLC-GC method seems to be a useful method of analysis.

We will be using this method (via an external laboratory) to monitor our raw materials and finished products on the level of MOSH/MOAH contamination.

Inproba will continue to evaluate its own supply chains, and will also continue to monitor developments on this issue.
